The boundaries of all the London Beis Din Eruvin can be found at **www.eruv.co.uk** where there are detailed maps of the Eruv boundaries. The website also has a feature to plan a walking route.

PLEASE NOTE the walking route planner is powered by a third party and may take you outside the Eruv. When this happens simply drag to the light blue line to within the Eruv boundary and the turn by turn instructions will guide you accordingly.

Due to some Halachic requirements and local conservation sensitivities, the natural walking route from NW London to The Royal Free Hospital is NOT within the new South Hampstead Eruv. (North End Way, Whitestone Pond & East Heath Road are OUT of the Eruv)

A route from NW London (starting from Finchley road) to The Royal Free Hospital keeping within the Eruv is shown below both in map and turn by turn format.



- Starting on Finchley Road outside Co-op junction with Hermitage Road
- 2. Continue along Finchley Road
- 3. Turn left onto Briardale Gardens
- 4. Turn right onto Platt's Lane
- 5. Turn immediately **Left** onto **Ferncroft Avenue**
- 6. Turn left onto Heath Drive
- 7. Turn right onto Redington Road

- 8. Turn Right onto Frognal
- 9. Turn left onto Church Row
- 10. Slight right to stay on Church Row
- 11. Turn right onto Heath Street
- 12. Turn left onto Perrin's Ct
- 13. Turn right onto Hampstead High Street
- 14. Turn left onto Pond Street
- 15. Arrive at **The Royal Free Hospital** on the **right**
